**STATE OF COLORADO
 PARAMEDIC RE-CERTIFICATION WORKSHEET**

A State of Colorado EMT Certificate may be renewed by completing one of the following options within the 3 year certification period:

- I. Completion of a Paramedic Refresher Course offered by a State EMS Division approved Education Group (plus additional continuing education topics such that the total education hours is no less that 50 hours) to include completion of a practical skills examination.**
- II. Completion of 50 hours of continuing education topic material as outlined in the worksheet below in addition to verification of skills competency.**
- III. Currently registered as a National Registry Paramedic**

In addition to the above requirements, the EMT-Paramedic must also have at the time of renewal:

- A current CPR card at the Healthcare Provider/Professional Rescuer level
- A current ACLS card
- A current fingerprint criminal history submitted to CBI and flagged for the EMS Division
- Signed affidavit of U.S Citizenship that is proven by a current government issued photo ID (must be a notarized copy if renewal submitted by mail)
